## **DOODLY** Wall Sticker Fitting Instructions

Thank you for buying a Bloobry wall sticker product. We hope that you will be very pleased with your purchase.

## **Before fitting**

Please make sure that your wall is smooth, clean, dry and dust free before

We recommend that new paintwork has been allowed to dry & cure for 3-4 weeks before fitting our wall stickers.

We do not advise applying to a wallpapered or textured surface.



Position your wall sticker, using the corner blocks to align with a spirit level if necessary.



Tape the corners in position with masking tape, and then apply a large centre hinge piece of tape down across the centre.



Gently, but firmly, rub the clear transfer layer onto the design with the squeegee.

The corner alignment blocks may be cut off when you are happy with the position of your clock.



Fold the design over across the centre hinge and gently peel the paper backing sheet away from the clear vinyl at 180°, keeping the free edge flat to the wall. Tape the clear layer to the wall, if it helps.



If any edges of the design remain stuck to the paper layer, gently ease it off using your fingertips to press it to the clear transfer layer. For clock designs, take care to transfer the centre dots which aid hanging the clock mechanism.



Cut away the paper backing layer, and cut off the corner alignment blocks.



Lay the design onto the wall with the clear layer, squeegeeing out from the centre. Then remove your centre hinge and peel away the other side of backing paper as before.



Rub the design firmly with the squeegee to bond the vinyl to your wall.



Starting with a top corner, peel back the application tape in a 45° direction, keeping the removed layer flush against the wall.



Using the shiny side of the backing paper against the wall, rub firmly to bond your sticker to the wall.



Your wall stickers should be maintenance free, but if you do need to clean them, please lightly use a damp cloth.

## Removal

If you need to remove your wall sticker, gently peel a corner and pull back along the wall. Stickers that are in a cool room or have been in place for a while may benefit from being gently warmed before removal.
