Dolly Dimples Crafts supplies used:

Pickle stamp set (from Dollywood)

Harmony stamp set (from Festival Dollies)

Hope stamp set (from Festival Dollies)

Layering Stamp set 3

#040 Moroccan Trellis stencil

Additional supplies:

white card

Black Ink (suitable for your colouring medium)

Distress Oxide: Picked Raspberry & Peacock Feathers

Blending brushes

Acrylic blocks

Glue

Colouring pens/pencils/paints

Created in a large Dylusions Journal

How to make this project:

- 1. Using Picked Raspberry and the Moroccan Trellis stencil, gently ink lightly over the page.
- 2. Using the circular layering stamp on a large block lightly add Peacock Feathers around the edge. Spritz with water and stamp onto your journal page,
- 3. Using the small sentiment stamp from Harmony stamp set, curve slightly to echo the edge of your created circle and the stamp multiple times around the edge using black ink.
- 4. Using your white card, stamp out Pickle, a selection of 11 clouds (from Harmony & Hope stamp sets), a butterfly (Hope stamp set) and your larger sentiment (from Pickle stamp set).
- 5. Colour all these images in your chosen medium. I used alcohol markers for Pickle and water colours for the other elements.
- 6. Once coloured and dry, cut out all your images and arrange on your journal page and glue into place.
- 7. Cut out your sentiment into several pieces, lightly ink over with pink and edge in black. Glue down on top of your clouds.
- 8. Ground Pickle with a light wash of green.
- 9. With black pen, doodle a border to frame your page.
- 10. Add black and white doodle accents using both black and white pens.
- 11. Taa Daaa, you're done.
