

Sydney in the moonlight

Dolly Dimples Crafts products:

Sydney the Badger stamp set (Dollywood 2) Funky Decoupage #15 Alter Me die set #7 Black card (250gsm) White card (300gsm)

Additional supplies:

Alcohol markers
Uni-ball white pigment pen
Memento Tuxedo Black

<u>Instructions</u>

- Step 1: From the Funky Decoupage #15 set, cut out the large square image.
- Step 2: Place the decoupage square over a sheet of white card and measure around to leave a boarder approx. 1cm. Cut to measure.
- Step 3: Place the prepared white card over a piece of black card and also measure approx. 1cm. Cut to measure.
- Step 4: Glue the decoupage sheet on top of the white card, then glue the white card on top of the black card.
- Step 5: Around the outer black edging, create a squiggle of your choice with the white pen. This will create a decorative boarder.
- Step 6: Stamp Sydney the Badger using the Memento dye pad. Using alcohol markers, colour Sydney in using your choice of colour. This project was made using blues and greens.
- Step 7: From the Alter Me die set #7, use the square/rectangle frame die. Place on top of a piece of white card and run the die through your die cutting machine. Colour the cut out die to match Sydney.
- Step 8: From the Funky Decoupage #15 set, fussy cut out some of the flowers and leaves, leaving a small cream boarder on each. This will enable them to stand out against the darker square image, when you put them in place.
- Step 9: Arrange the die cut to be behind Sydney the Badger and glue down. Glue Sydney the Badger slightly over the die cut. Then arrange the cut-out flowers and leaves and also glue them down.
