We specialise in rakes and from our extensive range you'll see a rake is 'not just a rake'. Our rakes are for general or specialist purposes and are designed with ease of use and reliability in mind.

We also offer snow shovels and equestrian forks.

Un-like the majority of rakes on the market many of our rakes feature angled or curved teeth, which provide a number of benefits. A short backward push will clean off wet leaves, grass, rubbish etc. We refer to this as 'self-cleaning'. For this type of work hold rake at approx a 70 degree angle.

When used at 45 degrees an angled or curved tooth can be particularly effective at creating seed beds, even from from

rough clay soil by raking back and forth in just a few minutes. The forward motion draws lumps of soil upwards while the backward motion breaks them down. (A straight edge tends to just push the lumps backwards)




Also, any slight damage that can occur from every day use can easily be sanded out. Lawn Maintenance




The majority of lawn rakes need to be light weight with 'gentle' teeth in order to prevent damaging established lawns, which makes our polypropylene range ideal. However, lawns that require maintenance will benefit from specifically designed steel rakes such as the 27S.
