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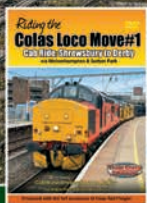

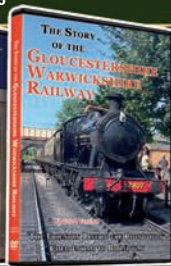

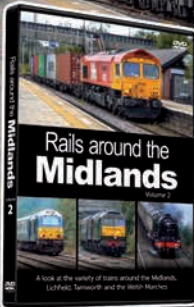

Hanseatic Towns in Steam

This programme begins with a trip on the Holland-Scandinavia Express and shows the Hamburg elevated railway, the S-Bahn network, the push-pull trains hauled by class 78 4-6-4 tanks from Bergedorf to Aumühle and Büchen, the Hamburg-Altona depot and station, as well as the main stations in Hamburg and Bremen. The film footage spans the 1960s through to 1971.

Weiden, Hof and the "Schiefe Ebene" This was steam on the Deutsche Bundesbahn - Part 1
The first in a series of films covering the last days of steam on the DB, which lasted into the 1970s. Whilst it starts with a short section of steam action at the station and depot of Hof, the last home of the 64 class of 2-6-2 tank locomotives, the bulk of this film concentrates on the "Schiefe Ebene" gradient in Bavaria, and at Neuenmarkt-Wirsberg, the lower station and depot and Hof which was the upper station and depot, although some distance beyond the summit.

This programme presents further unique film footage from the Ton Pruissen archive, shot on the famous "Rollbahn" between Bremen and Münster. The footage by the Dutch railway film pioneer was shot in various locations including Dreye, Kirchweyhe, Diepholz, Droehe and Bohmte, at the Krebsburg level crossing near Ostercappeln, in Belm and Vehrte, as well as at the stations and locomotive depots in Osnabrück and Münster. Landmarks such as the crossing of the Mittelland Canal and the Lengerich Tunnel are also captured on film. Impressive scenes show Franco-Crosti 2-10-0 locomotives of class 50.40 and the legendary streamlined "Black Swan" 10 001 in service. This is railway classicism at its finest: all 1960s; almost no computerised locomotive numbers, almost no overhead lines – but plenty of telegraph masts!

The Emsland line, Emden and Oldenburg

This was steam on the Deutsche Bundesbahn Part 4



In this film, Ton Pruissen takes us on a journey along the Emsland line to Emden and Oldenburg. His journey back in time to the 1960s begins in Rheine (before electrification) and, featuring many beautiful shots of the line, leads first to Leer. Scenes along the way include the Bentlage signal box and level crossing, Salzbergen station, the striking Hanekenfähr bridge over the Ems, and Lingen station and locomotive repair shop. The Dutch film pioneer was able to capture numerous scenes from the 1960s in Emden: at the locomotive depot, at Emden-Süd and Emden-West stations, and with a passenger train hauled by a class 82 from Emden-Außenhafen to Emden-West. Side trips to Norddeich-Mole and to Oldenburg in 1965 round off this unique historical programme.

2024 marked the 30th anniversary of Train Crazy railway videos and DVDs. Starting out as a hobby in 1994, just about every type of locomotive and unit has featured, with more than 400 passenger, freight, cab ride and tram titles, released on VHS tape, DVD, Blu-ray and download.

Here's the good bit... In the last few years, software to restore old grainy and wobbly film has become more accessible. Previously it was expensive, slow and not very good, but by 2024, huge advances were made. The old film used on these new compilation programmes is all being reworked, improved, cleaned up and upscaled. For the first time, all of the film shot in standard-definition (720 x 576 or less) can be upscaled and presented in top-quality high-definition (1920 x 1080).

The 16th programme in the 30th Anniversary series looks at the Class 66 & 67 locomotives in the period 1999 to 2012. First introduced in 1998, the EWS Class 66/0s paved the way for the next generation of freight locos for Britain's railways. Film from 1999 shows the low-numbered locos, as new, followed by the 66/5s & 66/6s for Freightliner, the GB 66/7s, DRS 66/4s and some odd locos, such as the Fastline 66/3s. The Class 67s are shown from new in 2000 hauling mail trains and TPOs, then Scottish sleepers, the Royal Train, Chiltern passenger trains plus charters and odd workings.

Presented in a no-nonsense format of on-screen captions with loco number, location and date, sit back and enjoy some top-quality action from 25 years ago - with much-improved picture quality and in HD for the very first time! This is far from a complete record of these locos during these years but this is what was filmed, now re-edited, re-worked and upscaled.

The Network Rail 97/3s work all freight, passenger, infrastructure monitoring and engineers trains on the Cambrian lines. These three former 37s are very well known, painted in their NR yellow livery, all named and all based at Coleham depot, just south of Shrewsbury.

In more recent times, Swietelsky-owned 37405 has been on hire to Colas, also based at Coleham and although not fitted with the ERTMS equipment for Cambrian work, the loco can be used behind the 97 to provide extra power or within/on the rear of trains in an engineering possession.

37405 and the 97s are periodically moved from Coleham to Derby RTC, Barrow Hill and Colwick depots for different jobs and maintenance and this cab ride features one such move, with 37405 and 97302, filmed in September 2025.

The route taken is very much as expected, running over a few lesser-seen curves and freight only lines, as the locos weave their way around the midlands. From Coleham, the rarely used curve at English Bridge Jn takes us forward to Wellington onto Cosford and then a pathing stop at Oxley Up Goods Loop. Forward to Wolverhampton, then Portobello Jn, Walsall and the freight-only Sutton Park branch to Water Orton, Tamworth, Burton OT and Derby.

The full journey is shown. Maps, on-screen captions and minimal narration. A trash cam in the back cab of 37405 records the loco at work and ambient sounds.

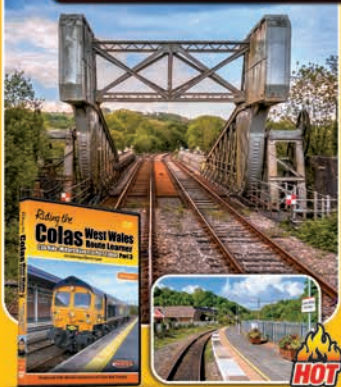

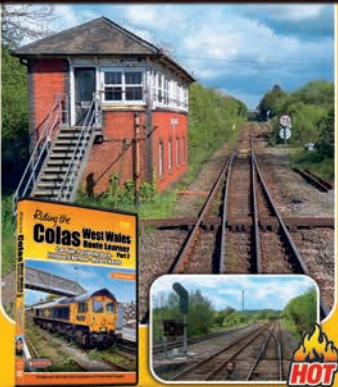

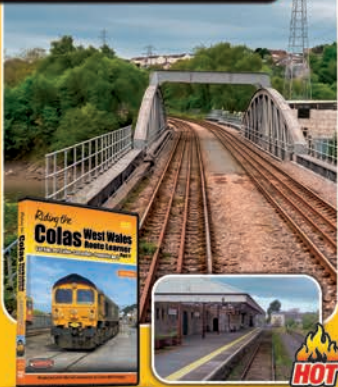

BIG FREIGHT 34

The start of 2026 saw big changes to the UK freight scene. Most notably for GBRf, with their Class 60s stored and offered for sale, their Class 69s also put into short-term store, more 66/6s introduced and their 99s gradually being delivered. Adding to this, the Freightliner/Heavy Haul split has seen the likes of Class 70s moving from container traffic to quarry stone workings. This edition of Big Freight looks at some of the changes and some of the freight highlights of recent times.

If you're a regular viewer, you know what's in store...
THIS IS BIG FREIGHT 34..!

This edition includes:

Quanton Stone Trains: Trains of quarry stone serving the HS2 virtual quarry just north of Aylesbury have been a highlight of recent times. Mostly operated by GBRf and DCR and originating from Tytherington, Machen and more recently Penmaenmawr, as it stands for now, these are the last regular Class 60 hauled trains in the country boosted with the addition of 60099, now back in service. A typical day is featured with the various moves.

Freightliner 90s: Following the split and sale of Freightliner as we previously knew it, 27 Class 90s now work in the DFLC pool, based at Crewe and these include the locos recently acquired from DB and the lower-numbered former Norwich based locos. Mostly painted in the orange and black livery, with a few celebrities - on a good day - 12 pairs should be in service and if all of the booked trains are running, seven or eight of these pairs run up and down the WCML each weeknight. Footage comes from Carlisle, Lancaster and Preston, with an attempt to film all 27 of them!

Derby Days: Derby, Stenson Junction and Spondon continue to provide a feast of traction highlights. From 60s on stone trains to 73s on IM, add steel, containers, oil, engineers, ballasts, unit moves and odd workings and you've almost got the lot! Highlights from visits during 2025 include the lesser-seen 37508 hauling a track machine and the final Class 70 Lindsey oil trains.

S&C Revisited: 2025 marked 150-years of the opening of the famous S&C route and following our extensive look at the freight flows over the line on Big Freight 32, we return to see the new branch to Horton Quarry now operational. A typical move is featured plus footage from Garsdale.

Plus: Milford Junction, Blackford Water Trains, Sand Saturdays and freight around the Midlands at Lichfield, Tamworth, Sutton Park and Elford.
