### **Configure Modes**

A mode is a preset group of settings that can be applied at the same time for a specific activity or environment, like reading, TV/theatre, outdoors, or indoors.

Customize each mode to your preferred settings. Later, set eSight to use the mode that most closely relates to your current activity or environment.

For example, you may like to control the focus and brightness manually while watching TV. You can customize the TV/theatre mode to use manual focus and manual brightness. When you're ready to watch TV, set eSight to TV/theatre mode and manually adjust the focus and brightness as necessary while watching TV.

When you're done watching TV, switch to a mode that has the best settings for your new activity.

### Customize a mode

i Go to Home Screen > Settings >
Configure mode > { Mode Name }.

### ii Go to Image brightness:

- Manual brightness Select if you want to manually set and lock the image brightness to a preferred level for an activity (like watching concerts or movies with fast changing lighting).
- Auto brightness Select if you want eSight to adjust the brightness.

#### iii Go to Focus:

- Manual Focus Set if you need to lock the focus at a preferred distance to prevent unwanted refocusing (while watching concerts or movies or reading).
- Auto Focus Select if you want eSight to adjust the focus.

## Generate a Wi-Fi QR Code

- iv From the Wi-Fi network type list, select the type of security (WEP, WPA, WPA2 or no encryption) used to secure the network.
- v Tap Create Wi-Fi Code.

# Stream Out, Cast, or Mirror Content

- eSight and your phone are paired via Bluetooth. See "Connect My Phone to eSight 4" on page 56.
- eSight and your phone are connected to the same Wi-Fi network. See "Setup WiFi on eSight 4" on page 57.
- eSight is turned on and within range of the Wi-Fi network.

#### Stream the eSight 4 Screen to the Phone Screen

eShare allows you to send the content of the eSight screen to your phone screen.
