





	<b>TWO-SPIRIT</b>	An umbrella term used by some indigenous North Americans which encompasses those who inhibit both masculine and feminine spirits within themselves.		<b>TRIGENDER</b>	A person whose gender identity changes between male, female and third gender.
	<b>TRANSGENDER</b>	A person whose gender identity is different from that which was assigned at birth.		<b>STRAIGHT ALLY</b>	A heterosexual individual who supports the LGBTQ+ community.
	<b>SKOLIOSEXUAL</b>	A person who is attracted to non-binary identified individuals.		<b>QUEER</b>	An umbrella term for sexual and gender identities that aren't heterosexual or cisgender.
	<b>POLYSEXUAL</b>	A person who identifies as non-binary and is attracted to others regardless of their gender identity.		<b>POLYAMORY</b>	Having more than one partner at a time, with the consent of all individuals involved.
	<b>PANSEXUAL</b>	A person who can be attracted to another person regardless of their gender.		<b>PANROMANTIC</b>	A person who feels romantic attraction regardless of the other person's gender.
	<b>OMNISEXUAL</b>	A person who is attracted to people of all genders.		<b>GENDER NON-BINARY</b>	A person who identifies outside of the gender binary of male and female.
	<b>NEUTROIS</b>	A person who does not identify with either male or female, and tend to feel that they fall somewhere between the two.		<b>LITHSEXUAL</b>	A person who experiences attraction but does not require this to be reciprocated.
	<b>LIPSTICK LESBIAN</b>	Lesbians that are heavily feminine in terms of their gender expression.		<b>LESBIAN</b>	A female who experiences attraction to other females.
	<b>INTERSEX</b>	A person who is born with any of several variations in sex characteristics. This can include genitalia, sex hormones and chromosomes.		<b>HERMAPHRODITE</b>	A person who has both male and female genitalia.
	<b>HETEROFLEXIBLE</b>	A person who is 'mostly' heterosexual but can experience minimal homosexual attractions.		<b>HOMOFLEXIBLE</b>	A person who is 'mostly' homosexual but can experience minimal heterosexual attractions.
	<b>GYNEPHILIA</b>	A person who is attracted to women or femininity, regardless of their gender identity.		<b>GREYROMANTIC</b>	An umbrella term used for Lithromantics and Demiromantics.
	<b>GENDERQUEER</b>	An umbrella term for people whose gender identity does not match that which they were assigned at birth.		<b>GENDERFLUID</b>	When a person's gender identity fluidly changes between male, female and neutral.
	<b>GAY BEAR</b>	Gay males who present as very masculine.		<b>GAY</b>	Males who are attracted to other males.
	<b>DRAG/FEATHER</b>	A person who dresses in clothing opposite to their gender.		<b>DEMISEXUAL</b>	Not experiencing physical attraction until a strong emotional bond is formed.
	<b>BISEXUAL</b>	A person who is attracted to both males and females.		<b>BIROMANTIC</b>	A person who is romantically attracted to two genders.
	<b>BIGENDER</b>	Experiencing exactly two gender identities, either simultaneously or interchanging.		<b>AUTOSEXUAL</b>	Preferring self-gratification.
	<b>ASEXUAL</b>	A person who experiences little or no physical attraction.		<b>AROMANTIC</b>	A person who does not experience romantic attraction.
	<b>ANDROPHILIA</b>	A person who experiences attraction towards men or masculinity regardless of their gender identity.		<b>ANDROGYNOUS</b>	An umbrella term used to describe those who exhibit both male and female gender identities and characteristics.
