

Reference: Fragrance raw material Mintlactone (CAS number 13341-72-5)

To whom it may concern,

On June 30th 2021 the International Fragrance Association, commonly known as IFRA, published its 50th Amendment which concerned the use of the established raw material commonly known as Mintlactone (aka Menthalactone) and registered with the CAS number 13341-72-5.

IFRA's 50th amendment has recommended that Mintlactone is no longer used as a raw material within fragrance oil formulations with the following implementation dates:

<u>For new fragrance submissions/creations</u>, no formulation containing Mintlactone should be made available or offered to customers for consideration on or after August 30th 2021.

<u>For existing fragrance compounds/formulations</u> (already in existence prior to 30th Aug 2021) containing Mintlactone, none of these existing fragrance compounds should be sold/made available to customers on or after July 30th 2022.

Fragrance Liaison Ltd can confirm that no fragrance oils available either currently or in the past contain Mintlactone, and our downstream fragrance house suppliers have confirmed that future fragrance submissions made to Fragrance Liaison Ltd will continue to be free from any inclusion of Mintlactone.
