

# Daisy Delights

## Shopping List

- A5 card blank
- White card
- Distress Ink
- Backing Papers
- Design Sheet
- String

## Thinking of you

**1** Turn your card so the spine is along the top, then from the left hand side measure across 12cm. From this point cut down 6.5cm. To make the stepper card, fold the step section over to make a crease line, then fold it back. To finish push the steps inside, fold the front score lines to create a mountain and valley.

**2** To create a gatefold, cut out a piece of card measuring 14.6cm x 23.3cm. Score at the following 6cm, 17.7cm. This will create your gatefold, then fix this to the left hand side of your card as shown.

*Make sure you do not*

*put any adhesive on the top part of your gatefold as it does not need any. The main gatefold will attach from the base to the middle as shown.*

**3** Cover the outside and inside of your gatefold, as well as the rest of your card with 2 contrasting

backing papers, attaching into place using double sided tape or craft glue.

**4** Cut out 2 toppers and fix to the card as shown using foam pads or silicone glue. If using silicone glue lay your work flat and leave it

to dry for at least an hour.

**5** Cut out a paper ribbon strip from your craft sheets and fix to the bottom right of the card with craft glue or double sided tape.

**6** Using the Wilted Violet distress ink and a blending tool, add definition to the card by rubbing ink around the white edges.

**7** Cut out your chosen sentiment topper and fix to the right hand side of the card along with a butterfly, fixing into place using foam pads or silicone glue. Fold the butterfly's wings back for extra dimension.

**8** Cut out another smaller sentiment and a tag. Attach to the gatefold section of the card as shown.

**9** Tie a knot using the string and fix to the top of the tag using craft glue to finish.
