

# Impressionist Landscapes with Oil

This is a one day workshop that will show you how to paint landscapes with oil paint in an impressionistic style. During the day you will be shown how to mix colours, paint trees, skies and rolling hills and how to use the oil paint both thick and thin in an alla prima way (in one go). By the end of the day you will have produced one oil painting. Suitable for all abilities.

Tools and materials needed for the workshop:

1 x canvas board at least A4 in size

A selection of oil painting brushes. I recommend one of the following:

4mm wide, 8mm wide, 16mm wide or equivalent, flat or round or combination of both.

1 x palette knife

Oil paint: 1 each of the following colours:

Titanium white, Cobalt Blue Hue, Cadmium Yellow Hue, Burnt Sienna, Paynes Grey or Black. Any make. Students quality will suffice such as Winsor Newton Winton or Daler Rowney Georgian

**Please do not bring strong smelling solvents into the classroom**

**Odourless solvents and mediums will be supplied by the tutor**

1 x palette (plastic, wood or a paper tear off palette)

Rags or tissues

Old shirt to wear when painting

A couple of small jamjars
