Watercolours - capturing light in lake reflections.
with Catherine Beale



There is nothing like watercolour's fantastic ability to create soft veils of colour! This day is all about loose, luminous watercolours as Catherine introduces you to her "gravity painting" techniques with this colourful lakeside scene. Learn to work swiftly from a plan. Pool paint within water to charge and merge colours. Use fewer brushstrokes and create subtle forms from water marks using your imagination.

Suitable for beginners or to help existing painters mix on the page and develop a looser style.

Materials needed for the workshop:

A3 Daler Rowney Aquafine Watercolour **Artboard (also £2 from Catherine on the day)**

A3 board to rest on plus something to tilt it with (eg tin/case.)

2B pencil and eraser

3 watercolour brushes: one inch flat; 3/8 or half inch or small flat; rigger or fine brush.

Kitchen roll

Palette with several big wells or white china plates

Table salt

Tubed watercolour paint suggested colours:

Indigo; ultramarine blue; turquoise; violet/mauve; opera pink; raw sienna; burnt umber; sap green.
