
# Vignettes in Watercolour Fri. 26th Jan 2024

## Course outline

Vignettes are about capturing small areas of a larger object or scene and fading the edges. Ideal for sketchbooks, they can be relatively quick and far less daunting than trying to paint a whole scene. Its a great place to start watercolour. We will use primarily watercolour and a little pen where helpful. This workshop is primarily for complete beginners with the focus being to provide each student with the basic skills to enable them to start their watercolour journey.

### Materials required.

A4 landscape sketchbook for watercolour. 2B pencil, eraser, waterproof fine liner 0.3mm, set of watercolour paints. Ideally including 2 of each primary. Eg: Cadmium yellow, Lemon yellow, Cobalt blue, Ultramarine blue, Alizarin crimson,

Light Red, Yellow Ochre, Burnt Umber & Burnt Sienna. A selection of synthetic watercolour brushes No. 2, 6, 8 & 10. A beginners set is adequate. Palette for mixing, an old dinner plate is ideal. If you have no paints at all, the tutor can provide sufficient qty. of artist quality paints. Fee £8 payable to the tutor.

#### **Tutor Biography:**

Marks teaching cuts through the jargon that can deter beginners. His no nonsense, hands on approach gives beginners the confidence to get paint on paper and produce very pleasing results in a short space of time. When he is not producing his own work, Mark is a regular at the bookshop. He taught in Marlborough College Summer School in 2022, and offers private tuition.
