

Beginners Watercolour Workshop

Watercolour painting is both enjoyable and rewarding. Learning the basic techniques such as washes and wet in wet is essential to further your journey with watercolour. Painting small simple sketches gives you the opportunity to develop your confidence in the techniques.

We will start the morning with a brief look at the equipment we need ie paper, paints, brushes which can be confusing when purchasing for the first time.

Our painting will start with basic washes, that can be used for skies or backgrounds, before going onto some simple sketches that will incorporate all of the essential techniques. You will be able to follow my step by step demonstrations and together we can start your journey into watercolour painting.

Suitable for complete beginners.

If possible please bring along:

- Watercolour paper, plus spare for practise and testing (bockingford 140lb Not surface is a good all round inexpensive paper)
- Watercolour paints/ mixing plate or palette.
- Selection of brushes
- Pencils, rubber and masking tape
- Rag or kitchen roll

I do have a few spare brushes, paints etc, you can also purchase in the shop when you know what you will need.
