

How I Clean a Bronze Artefact with The Composite Cleaning Pencil

*Please note

Any found artefact should be completely dry before attempting to clean and conserve.

I am cleaning a Medieval Bronze key part and will use the following cleaning tools for this process.



With the Brass Brush attachment clean with light controlled strokes to remove the excess dirt.



For the hard to get into areas there are two brass inserts that are quite effective for this process , the brass scrapper and fine brass insert.



Getting into the smallest of gaps and even the legends of coin lettering this insert is very comfortable to work with



After this process I then gave the surface a careful once over with the composite white insert to smooth and remove the last of the hardened dirt.



A light brush to remove the dust , I now apply Preserve IT Microcrystalline Wax Blend, I leave for a few minutes in a warm area and then lightly buff over with a soft clean shoe brush
