We recommend you read this document thoroughly to familiarise yourself with how your product works, how you should use it safely and effectively and how to look after your product to ensure it continues working as it should.





Product Information

Hand sculpted from pink rock salt, your lamp is designed to emit negative ions, counteracting allergens and pollutants in the air.

The improved air quality and warm glow of the lamp promotes relaxation and is thought to help improve sleep quality and reduce tension.

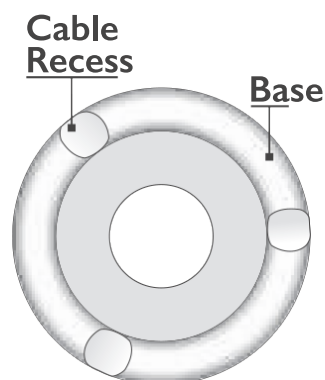

How to use...

Operation

Before operating your lamp, place it on a stable surface with the cable routed through the cable recess. Insert the mains plug into a power socket and use the inline switch to turn the unit on or off. Care should be taken to ensure that any trailing cable cannot be accessed by children or pets.

The lamp may be used for extended periods, with the heat generated by the bulb helping to regulate absorbed moisture. It is recommended that the lamp is placed on a coaster or decorative plate to avoid marking furniture. As with any electrical appliance, the unit should not be left unattended for long periods.

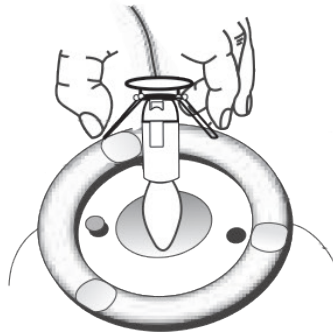




Changing the Bulb

The lamp uses a 15W bulb with an E14 screw fitting. To install or replace the bulb follow the steps below:

1. Unplug the lamp from the mains power and allow to cool if recently used.
2. Place on a low, stable surface such that it cannot fall and cause injury and turn the lamp over so that the electrical element is accessible.
3. Gently pull on the base of the lamp holder to compress the clips and allow it to pull free of the base cavity.
4. Install the bulb or if replacing an existing bulb, unscrew the old bulb and screw in the new bulb.
5. Hold the retaining clips against the column of the lamp holder and insert into the base cavity (see diagram to right).
6. Push the lamp holder home such that it is flush with the base.



How to look after...

Your Himalayan Salt Lamp is hydroscopic, meaning that it will naturally absorb water from the surrounding air. Using the lamp allows the absorbed moisture to evaporate. It is recommended that you place the lamp on a coaster or decorative plate to avoid leaving marks on furniture.

As a natural material, the salt used in your lamp can be easily damaged if knocked or dropped. Take care when handling your lamp and do not place your lamp in direct sunlight.

Cleaning and Storage

1. Before cleaning, unplug the lamp and remove the electrical element.
2. Use a dry or slightly damp cotton cloth to remove dust and a dry cotton towel to remove excess moisture and crystals
3. If the lamp is to be left for an extended period, seal the unit tightly in a plastic bag and store in a dry environment. You may use the silica gel sachets to help combat moisture inside the bag.





Safety Information

1. Any electrical device poses a fire hazard if the product becomes damaged, defective or is used incorrectly.
2. Do not permit children to play with this device. Cleaning and maintenance should not be completed by children without supervision.
3. Household pets may instinctively lick the lamp to replenish the minerals in their body. Excessive salt can cause serious health issues and steps should be taken to restrict any access to the lamp.
4. The lamp may generate heat while operating - make sure it remains well ventilated.
5. The lamp should be placed in order to minimise the risk it may fall, avoiding the instance of any trailing cord. A falling lamp can cause significant injury.
6. Do not use or store your lamp in an area of high humidity such as a bathroom or kitchen and never sprinkle your lamp with water.
7. If the lamp becomes damp or water begins to collect under the lamp, it should be unplugged immediately. Remove and inspect the electrical element of the lamp to ensure there are no signs of moisture or corrosion. Place in a warm, dry environment to allow excess moisture to evaporate.
8. Use a damp cloth to clean the unit and its accessories. Do not use abrasive chemicals, cleaning solvents or strong detergents. If the lamp gets wet, unplug and leave in strong sunlight for 4 - 5 hours before brushing off any excess salt crystals.
