This manual is to be used in addition to the standard AJL air fed unit manual



1. Setup & Inspection

Choose a safe location

Flat, level, obstacle-free ground—no rocks, sharp debris, roots, slopes, fences, or overhead hazards.

Ensure at least 0.5 m clearance on each side.

Secure anchoring

Use all provided D-rings with ground stakes

Inspect every anchor point before each session.

Blower & water setup

Use a dedicated 20 A circuit within 30 m of the slide.

Water hose must reach full length with even spray.

Pre-use inspection

Fully inflate slide. Check for tears, weak seams, or sagging.

Test water flow—surface must be consistently wet and slippery.

2. Staffing & Supervision

Assign responsible supervisors

At least two trained adults should monitor usage continuously.

Age, size, and weight grouping

Group users by size/age; avoid mixing very young and older participants.

Recommended minimum age 5 years / 42" (107 cm), maximum rider height 6' / 183 cm, weight limit ~68 kg.

Capacity limits

Only one person slides at a time to avoid collisions and injury

Allow the previous rider to fully exit before the next enters.

3. Proper Use Guidelines

Slide head-first prohibition

All riders must slide seated or feet-first. No head-first sliding.

No jumping or climbing on sides

Slides must be used only on the sliding surface; no side access.

No rough play

No pushing, colliding, or dangerous behavior.

No food or sharp objects

Remove shoes, eyeglasses, jewelry, pens, etc. Keep food, drinks, and gum away.

Wind policy

Do not operate in winds over ~23 mph. If winds rise, evacuate and deflate immediately.

Power loss or blower failure

Immediately assist riders off the slide. Do not allow re-entry until fully reinflated and stable.

Puncture or deflation

If punctured or deflated, clear slide, fully deflate, then repair.

Weather hazards

Immediately stop use in storms, heavy rain, lightning, or adverse conditions.

5. Maintenance & Hygiene

Cleaning

After use, rinse with clean water and very mild child skin friendly detergent. Dry thoroughly before storage. Ensure you clean within 24 hours of use.

Repair kits

Keep repair patch kit on hand for minor damage.

Storage

Store clean and fully dry in a cool, dark place to avoid mildew and material degradation.

8. Water pH Maintenance for End Pool Safety

To ensure the health and comfort of all users, it's essential to maintain the pH level of the pool at the end of the inflatable slip and slide within a safe and comfortable range. Improper pH levels can cause eye and skin irritation, degrade the inflatable material, and reduce the effectiveness of any sanitizing treatments.

✓ Safe pH Range

Ideal pH level: 7.2 – 7.6

Acceptable range: 7.0 - 7.8

A pH level below 7.0 is too acidic and may cause skin and eye irritation and damage the inflatable.

A pH level above 7.8 may reduce chlorine effectiveness and lead to cloudy water or skin dryness.

Testing Guidelines

Use a pool water test kit (liquid or strip-based) before each use and every 4–6 hours during extended use.

Test for:

pH level

Chlorine or other sanitizers (if used)

Alkalinity (if managing chemically treated water)

If Using Fresh Tap Water (No Chlorine)

While untreated water may be acceptable for short durations, monitor pH closely.

Drain and refill daily or between events if sanitiser is not used.

Warning Signs of Improper pH

Red or irritated eyes

Itchy or dry skin

Cloudy water

Inflatable surface feels slimy or degraded

If any of these occur, stop use immediately, test the water, and adjust pH as needed.
