Security is dependent on the quality of the padlock used (not supplied). Robox Design is not responsible for failures related to the third-party padlock."

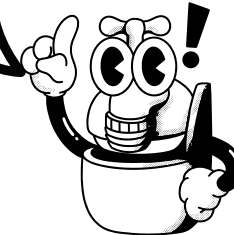
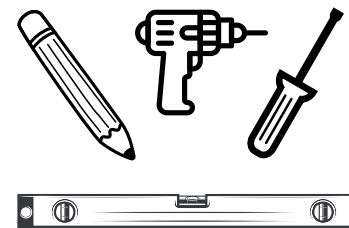

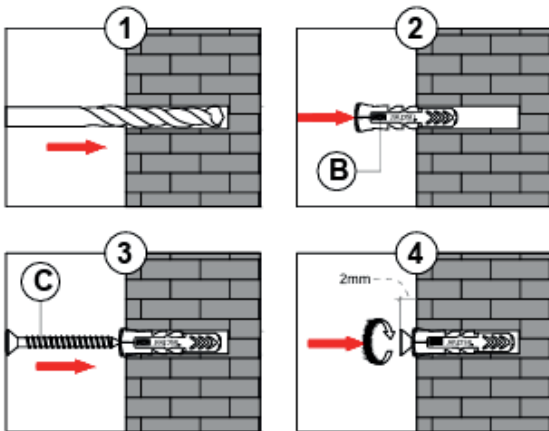


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3.0 INSTALLATION STEPS

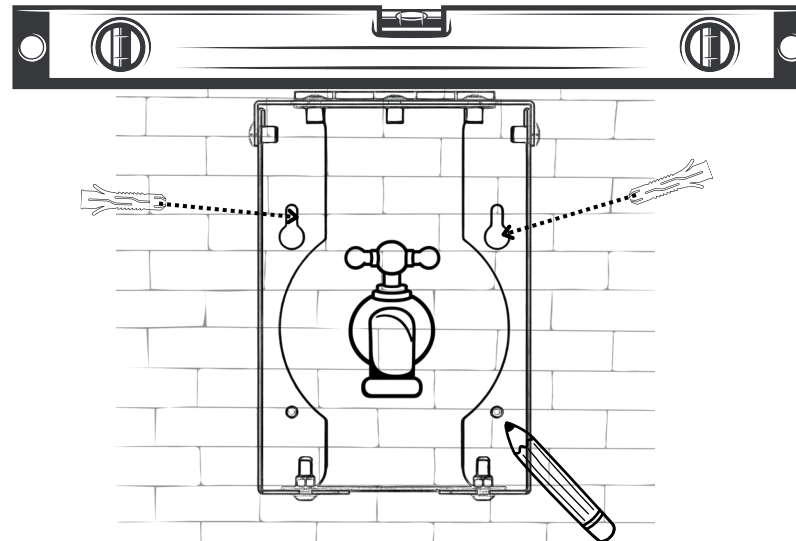


Ensure correct fixings are used for the wall material . If in doubt seek professional advice



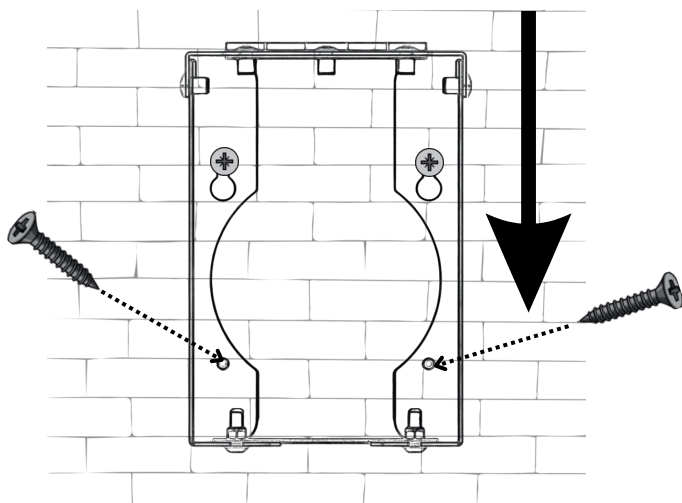
STEP.1

The fittings supplied with the Tap Jaw require a 6mm hole. Fit plugs as shown above.



STEP.2

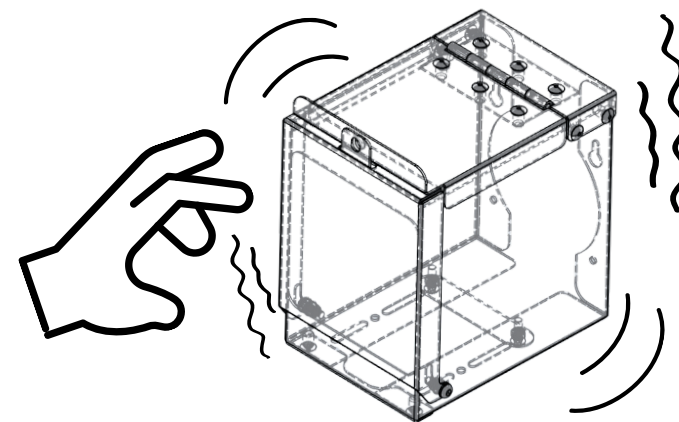
Drill holes for top key hole slot first, add screws and leave proud by about 2mm. Hang box of these screws and mark remaining holes.



STEP.3

Reposition box on wall on top screws, pull down to ensure keyhole slots engage. Recheck level. Mark position of lower holes and add remaining screws and tighten

Upon completion, verify that the unit is securely fastened and flush against the mounting surface. The installer must confirm that all fixings are fully tightened and that the enclosure remains stable during the operation of the doors. Correct alignment and secure mounting are required to ensure the unit remains in place, offers maximum security and functions as intended.



Care and Maintenance Periodically clean the unit using a soft cloth and mild detergent to remove debris. Avoid abrasive pads or harsh/chlorine containing chemicals, as these will damage the protective finish and reduce corrosion resistance.

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
