Orchard Terrace is located off King Street in Glastonbury - as you drive up King Street from either end, the road turns 90 degrees, the access ramp to Orchard Terrace is on the corner of this bend. Holly Tree Cottage (5 Orchard Terrace) is the one with the big green garage door!

FROM THE BUS STOP - HIGH STREET GLASTONBURY -

From the Bus Stop, walk towards Glastonbury Market Cross on the corner of the High Street (30 yds) then find Northoad Street and walk approx 200 yds along Northload Street - do not turn off and stay on the RHS. You will need to turn right on the 6th road you go past from the Market Cross just after the Norlet Court turning - this is King Street and it is quite narrow. As you walk up King Street, in front of you (25 yds) is the ramp for Orchard Terrace. Holly Treet Cottage is number 5 Orchard Terrace and has a BIG GREEN GARAGE at the front of the house.

KEY SAFE - the key safe is located at the back of the garage. Once you have found Holly Tree Cottage (5 Orchard Terrace) please open the wooden gate (with "5" on it) and walk down the side of the garage - at the rear of the garage on your left is the key safe, next to the rear garage entrance door.

KEY SAFE CODE = 1207

In the key safe are 3 metal keys and 1 x electronic garage door key. The two green tagged keys are for the front door of the house and the other is for the rear garage entrance door if you need it - for the garage entrance door, you have to put the key in the lock upside down lol - well it is Glastonbury!

The rear garage entrance door needs a good slam, with the handle down to close it - we have new one on order.

GARAGE DOOR REMOTE CONTROL -

The green remote control simply needs to be pressed in to operate the garage door -

PLEASE REMEMBER TO LET THE DOOR GO FULLY UP BEFORE DRIVING IN/OUT



General

- The wifi network **Truespeed_546B5** is and the password is **acpxfd15pf** there is also a **QRCode** that you can point your phone at on our website and in the house
- Depending on your provider there may be limited phone signal and it might be more effective to use wifi calling
- Keys for the patio doors to the garden are in the lock on the door
- Cushions for the patio chairs are in the understairs cupboard next to the kitchen
- No smoking or vaping inside the house
- Please be quiet between 10pm and 8am
- The private garden is for your use. It is south facing and gets warm, please take care of your skin!
- The access to the house is either from the back door at the garage or via the garden gate adjacent to garage. There are some steps down into the garden and again onto the patio and front door

HOUSE RULES

A reminder of the 'house rules' as on the AirBnB and Booking.com listing: thank you for your co-operation.

- Quiet hours 22.00-08.00: please be respectful of our neighbours.
- No parties, no events or extra guests (which invalidate our insurance)
- No smoking/vaping anywhere inside the property
- Please leave the house as clean and as tidy as it was when you arrived
- All rubbish must be put in the garage in the appropriate bins
- Report all breakages as soon as you can

Dogs

If you have come with your beloved pooches, **please do not allow them upstairs**. There are treats available (if they are good!) on top of the fridge. Here also you will find poo bags, please ensure you clean up after your dogs in the garden and place the poo bags in the black refuse bins in the garage. There is a spare lead if you have forgotten yours.

Heating/hot water

The heating and hot water are run by the combi boiler in the loft. The hot water heats as you run the taps and it may take a few seconds to run hot. The heating has a thermostat via Google Nest, a small circular display in the living room. This can be altered manually by touching the dial. However, whilst we want you to be warm and cosy, please do not run the heating with the doors and windows open. Let's all think of our footprint on the planet. Thank you.

Electricity

In the event of a power cut (unlikely) - the trip switches are in the hall by the front door. Check here first if the electricity goes off and flip the switch up that has tripped.

Kitchen

- Fridge and small freezer. Please leave always switched on. Any food you leave behind will be donated to the many charities in town that help to feed those less fortunate.
- Fan assisted oven. The oven door should be kept slightly open when using the grill.
- Ceramic hob. Please be aware that the hob may remain warm after you have finished using it.
- Extractor. The switch for this is on the back wall near the sockets. Please have the fan on when cooking.
- Dishwasher. Tablets by the sink. These also contain rinse aid and are plastic free.
- Fire blanket.
- Rubbish. There is a bin by the fridge. The left-hand side is for anything that cannot be recycled and will end up in landfill (let's not fill this one up!) Right hand side for all recyclables, glass, tins, foil, hard plastic & paper. Small brown bin (under sink) – food waste. These can be emptied into the appropriate bins in the garage.
- Kettle and toaster.
- Spare tea towels. These are in the drawers in the kitchen.
- CO alarm.

Equipment. We hope you find everything you need but please ask if there is something you require.

Bathroom

- Please open the window slightly after using the shower for a few minutes.
- The lights above the mirror are operated by a switch to the right-hand side of the mirror. Please remember to switch it off after you've finished admiring yourself.
- The towel rail warmed via the heating system.
- Spare toilet rolls are on the shelf in the bathroom.
- Please place sanitary products in the bin provided.
- An emergency kit/forgotten items are available for your use.
- The bedside light in the second bedroom is operated via touch control.

Downstairs

- The fireplace in the lounge is not working.... please do not try and light a fire!
- Smoke alarm on the wall in the kitchen, designed to test your cooking skills!
- In the conservatory at the back the led lights are operated by a remote control. There are also books and games, please leave them for someone else to enjoy.
- TV with remote control using Amazon TV.



ΤV

Use the LARGE remote to turn the TV on (1) and then press the home button (2) on the smaller AMAZON remote to watch TV.

The on screen firestick passcode, if you ever need it = 1204

1 - click the on/off button on the big remote "1" to turn on/off

2 - click the home button on the amazon remote "2" to see the TV channels
3 - if you cannot see the program choices - click the source button "3" on the big remote and scroll down to HDMI-CEC as shown below
